Wow; what a great question last night. What is the Holy Spirit of the Trinity? This is a follow up on the short answer I gave. Pull out your bibles. Mostly Saint John with a little bit of St Paul.

Three persons; one God....

God the Father God is the Word

"In the beginning was the word and the word was with God and the word was God" (John 1:1). The word of God is responsible for all creation and we have the word of God in the books of the bible. For many protestant sects that's it, the bible and what is in it only. For Catholics the Word of God is not only in the Bible but also living and fresh and with us every moment, today until the end of times...

"For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and spirit, of joints and marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And before him no creature is hidden, but all are open and laid bare to the eyes of him with whom we have to do" (Heb. 4:12-13)

God the Son - Jesus is God Incarnate

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us full of grace and truth.... John 1:14. Incarnate is a Latin term meaning to make flesh. Jesus, the incarnate form of God came into the world to redeem mankind. It is through Jesus Christ we are to be saved. "Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but by Me." (John 14:6)

God the Holy Spirit - The Holy Spirit is God's Will in action.

God projects his Will through the Holy Spirit in the form of Christian action. The bible uses different terms like water, fire, wind and breath... It all defines the will of God being worked through the Holy Spirit. Some religious sects like the Jehovah Witnesses, hold that God the Spirit is not an independent person from God the Father or God the Son. Some versions of the Bible do not capitalize the name of the Holy Spirit, which is meant to diminish the Holy Spirit in relation to God and to Jesus.

The Holy Spirit is a distinct person of the Trinity. Some examples from the Gospel of John. John 14:26 John 16:7-14
