Thoughts on Temptation and Spiritual Warfare

So why does God permit us to be tempted? Why does God allow demons to torment and persecute us?

As with so many things in life, it is through adversity and struggle that we develop strength and virtue. This is true in the physical world. It is also true in the spiritual world. Demons cannot do anything that God does not permit. God permits demons to influence us, to tempt us, in order that we may develop spiritually according to God's plan.

Everyone has certain weaknesses. The very area in which we continually fall into sin and struggle with, is the very area in which God wants us to be purified, to develop perfection and virtue. Lust, anger, pride, blasphemy; all of these and more are area's God wants us to be purified of. In the struggle to avoid a particular sin we become stronger. We develop virtue, and fulfill God's calling.

If we were never put to the test in some way or another. If we did not have adversity in some form or another, we would never develop our senses, we would never develop our muscles, we would never develop our mind. We did not learn to walk without struggle. We did not learn to reason without developing our minds. Similarly, we would never develop virtue if we were not put to the test.

God allows demons into our life to move us one way or another, to force us to fight back and strengthen our virtue. When we fight back against sin, when we resist temptation, we are following God's plan for us; a plan which includes our eternal salvation.

So why are some tempted in a certain way and others are tempted in another? God likes variety. Consider God's creation on earth. Look around you at the variety in God's creation. There are no two things exactly alike. In this variety, God finds perfection. Similarly, we are each called to spiritually develop in different ways according to the virtues God wants us to have. We each have our road to travel. We each have our cross to bear and no two roads or crosses are exactly the same.

Spiritual warfare extends beyond attacks on individuals to nations, societies, cultures, and even Holy Church. Why would God allow the Church to be attacked? For the same reasons he allows us to be attacked. So that we may strive together that we may be purified. For in the struggle, we will by necessity put on the full armor of Christ and strengthen our Christian virtue.

The struggle is never easy and can be lifelong. Consider; in the making of tempered steel, iron is heated in a crucible nearly to its melting point to remove impurities. It is then plunged into water and hammered to strengthen it. In the making of steel the metal is pushed to its limits by the master craftsman. The craftsman is wise and knows well what the limits of the metal are, and is careful never to push the metal beyond its limits. In the end the steel is strong and resilient. It is useful for its intended purpose. We are in our crucible now, but have courage because we are in the hands of God. He will not push us beyond our limits.
