To be a Saint – Happiness is to be Found in Simplicity

"Where your treasure is, there will your heart be also" Mt 6:21

Simplicity has been described as an inward reality that results in an outward lifestyle.

Much has been said in these letters about the dangers of materialism, and this age of self-indulgence. There are other factors to consider in order to develop a simpler lifestyle. Let's take a look at three of them.

Simplifying a lifestyle not only means to reduce the clutter of your life in terms of material things and possessions, but the clutter of our thoughts. How many negative thoughts do we harbor? Thoughts stemming from personal relationships, or something that has happened to us. Maybe thoughts revolving around the state of the world, politics, or the day-to-day drudgery of life. Thoughts that needlessly occupy our mind, cluttering it with worry and anxiety. We have the power to end them, but we return to them. Why? Do they give us some type of pleasure? Do we gain some type of knowledge, insight or benefit from dwelling on them? Let these thoughts go. Cut them out of our life and move on. There is no profit for us by dwelling on negative thoughts. In the end they will makes us bitter, and lead us to negative actions.

Another area which will serve to simplify our life is in our personal relationships. In this age, everyone is seemingly seeking to be connected to everyone else, mainly through social media, but in other forms also. There is a growing acceptance to seek out and cultivate relationships with numerous people, some we hardly know, others we do not know at all, except maybe a screen name on a post. It is not necessarily wrong to reach out, even commendable, if in the reaching, we are seeking to help others, but there is a danger here. We are empathetic by nature. We share feelings with each other, good or bad, and are sensitive to those feelings. Complex relationships are exhausting and draining to the spirit, and can even be manipulated by others. Would it not be better, simpler, to focus your energy on those closest to you; starting with God, then your spouse and your family?

For those whose job it is to deal with people and work with others on a daily basis, this can be an unavoidable problem. One reason personal retreats are so effective is that it gives you the ability to rest and recover; "detox" from the negative pressures of life and to focus and renew our relationship with God. Let Jesus set the example. In the Gospel of Mark when His apostles came back from preaching the Word of God, he told them to "Come away by yourself to a lonely place and rest awhile." Mk 6:31. Jesus also needed to get away from the crowd from time to time. Consider the passages of Lk. 5:15-16, and Mt 14:23. It is often in solitude and silence that we regain our strength and focus. Coincidently, it is for me the best time to talk to God.

That leads us into the last area. Take time for prayer. Just yourself and God. That is all. Make it an intimate time where you can free yourself from everything in this world and share your most personal thoughts and feelings. Start small but be persistent

in this. It is in this personal relationship with God that you will receive the true peace that is so elusive in life. In this only, nothing else.

The more complex life is, the more confusion and duplicity we encounter. It is in simplicity that we find truth. It is in simplicity that we find true happiness. The rest is an illusion. The less our life revolves around material things and emotional baggage, the more room we have for Christ.
