To be a Saint – Our Father

There is nothing more fundamental, nothing more basic to Christian prayer, then the Lord's Prayer. It was taught to the Apostles by Jesus. It is prayed at every celebration of the Mass and every Devine Liturgy, and recited daily by millions of souls. Yet, how do we pray it? Do we ever take time to think about what we are praying, or do we rush through the words? Do we ever contemplate the meaning?

In this letter we will consider just the first two words. That's right; "Our Father". Jesus began this prayer with two simple words, each one packed with significance. Jesus could have begun the prayer using the words The Father, which is a non-descript way of naming someone without an intimate connection to us. He could have started by saying All Mighty Father, which is true, but still something far separated from us, something seemingly unattainable. Jesus could have also started with the words, My Father, he would have been correct, for Jesus is the Son of God, but the word my is singular in nature, God is more than that. No, Jesus gave the name of "Our Father", and with that He immediately gave us a God beyond our hopes and fondest dreams.

"Our Father" signals to us that we have a God that is Father to all, sinners and saints. With that we have a God that is approachable. A God that will never turn away His child, no matter what the child has done. A Father that offers us wisdom and understanding, and an abundance of blessings and good things. Above all, a Father that offers us mercy. Consider the Father in the story of the Prodigal Son.

"And he rose and came to his father. But while he was yet at a distance, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and embraced him and kissed him. And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son.' But the father said to his servants, 'Bring quickly the best robe and put it on him. And put a ring on his hand and shoes on his feet. And bring the fatted calf and kill it and let us eat and make

merry for this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost and is found.'" LK 15: 20-24

This father in the parable is "Our" Father. When we invoke His name in the Lord's Prayer, consider the magnitude of what we are saying.

There is another aspect to the term of Our Father. A connection often overlooked. We do so at a tremendous loss. By naming God as Our Father. Jesus connected us to Himself as His brothers and sisters. Yes, we have the same spiritual Father in heaven. This term is an example of Jesus' love and humility. Jesus, the true Son of God, deemed it right and good to extend what was truly His by birth-right, to all of us. No matter our state in life, if we do the will of God, we are spiritual brethren to Jesus. Listen to words in Matthew about the true kindred of Jesus.

"For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and my sister and my mother." Mt. 12:50

This message is consistent with Christ's teachings throughout the Gospels, and indeed the New Testament writings. We are to love one another as Jesus has loved us. We love one another, and forgive one another, as brothers and sisters in Christ.

The next time we say the Lord's Prayer, privately or publicly, consider what we are saying. I recommend we do what Saint Thresa of Avila instructed the Nuns of her convent.

Pray as if Jesus Himself were standing next to you, instructing you, as He did the Apostles so long ago, in how to properly pray to "Our Father"
