Cultural Marxism, and the Tentacles of Socialism - Antonio Gramsci
According to the 2020 Annual Report on U.S. attitudes toward Socialism:
- 40% of Americans have a favorable view of socialism, up from 36% in 2019. - 37% of Gen Z and Millennials (compared to 5% of the Silent Generation), believe the Communist Manifesto <a href="https://doi.org/10.2016/journal.com/better-guarantees-freedom-and-equality-over-beclaration-of-Independence">better guarantees-freedom-and-equality-over-beclaration-of-Independence</a>.

We've discussed socialism before, particular the brand of Marxist Socialism. We also have discussed some of the key characters; names such as Immanuel Kant, Friedrich Hegel. We've discussed Marx, Engels, and Lenin. We will come forward in time now and add a name to the list, Antonio Gramsci. To understand what is happening in America you have to look at Italy in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century.

First, a brief review. We have a general understanding of Karl Marx's Communist Manifesto, class warfare and anti-religious message. Marx himself was heavily influenced by the German philosophers Immanuel Kant and George Fredrick Hegel. All of them were influenced in part with the idealism and atheist ideology that sprang from the French Revolution and before. Now, let's begin our trip to Italy....

Antonio Gramsci, born in 1891, was a founder of the Italian Communist party. He moved to Russia in the 1920s where he expected to find that Marxism really worked. It didn't take long for Gramsci to realize that Russia's people were being held in check by terror. He thought this style of rule was unnecessary, even counterproductive. He moved back to Italy in the late 1920s, where he was sent to prison by Mussolini's fascist government.

Over the next nine years, until his death, he assembled his thoughts on how a nation could be made into a "Marxist paradise". His "Prison" notebooks were very influential, and became a primer for other socialists.

This next part is important to understand what has happened in America in the form of Cultural Marxism. Gramsci's strategy did not call for a confrontational revolution as had happened in Russia, instead it called for a **gradual softening up the people by steering them away from their cultural foundations, moral values, faith in God, love of country, reliance on family, and attachment to the churches, schools, and other anchors.** 

Gramsci stressed in his writings that Christianity was a primary enemy of the Communist Revolution. In particular, Christian teachings of the importance of the nuclear family and the role of the father in the family were primary obstacles to communism. Like Marx, Gramsci advocated attacking and demeaning Christianity, the nuclear family, and fatherhood ("Patriarchy"). Gramsci advocated infiltration of cultural Marxists in the media, entertainment, courts, and politics.

Gramsci noted that a true Marxist "uprising of the workers" in the United States would never be successful. It would first require an undermining of the culture – of the

morality and norms. It would require a *changing* of the culture. But it would also require something else. Gramsci felt the movement would require a more subversive, directly participating element – community organizers..... It would also require the media.

Gramsci's ideas made it to America through a variety of ways. One way was via a group of political activists and intellectuals known as the "Frankfort School". The members of the Frankfurt School tried to develop a theory of society that was based on Marxism and other disciplines. They used basic Marxist concepts to analyze the social relations within capitalist economic systems. This approach became known as "critical theory". This term should sound familiar. Members of this group adopted and advocated for Gramsci's strategy of implementing Cultural Marxism. However, as they were based in Germany, they had to flee from Hitler's fascist government. In 1933, they were offered facilities at the Institute for Social Research at Columbia University, USA. That's right; the citadel of American journalism. So how can we defeat Cultural Marxism? Socialists tell you up front what they fear; and thereby how you can defeat them. "Socialism will triumph by first capturing the culture via infiltration of schools, universities, churches and the media by transforming the consciousness of society" – Antonio Gramsci. These, and his other writings tell us clearly how to defeat Cultural Marxism.

We must hold firm to our Christian faith and values. We must hold firm to the values of a nuclear family and traditional roles of Father and Mother. We must play an active part in educating our children as to the dangers of socialism in all of its forms, according to their understanding. We must vote, select, choose, and advocate those who will best uphold our American traditions and values at all levels, from the school board to the President. Most of all we must turn to God. It is only in God that we will find victory. Love Dad
