### A Mother's Heart

It's always risky business for a writer to craft a story about something that they have no experience in. It always comes off as phony. So then, I make no pretense in claiming to know anything about being a mother. I do however know well what I've seen mothers do, and it is awe inspiring.

I believe all women have the qualities of motherhood locked within them, and those qualities speak to something of the divine. Those qualities begin to surface and develop early on as a child. It may start with listening to a mother's voice and spending time with her. I do think the maternal instinct develops rapidly as the family grows, especially with taking care of siblings. Other qualities begin to surface a little later, in the form of a sense of fairness and approach to life. I would say by a time a girl marries; those qualities come into to full display. For I believe it is a young wife's maternal and domestic instincts and qualities that smooths her husband's rough approach to life. Indeed, I could make a case that it is the wife that prepares her husband to be a father.

Mothers are first and foremost there for their children. Tender, nurturing, and fiercely protective. There is nothing fiercer than a mother protecting her young. Similarly, there is no one who willingly sacrifices themselves for their children and family more than a mother. The first, and possibly largest sacrifice they make is their careers. Much is made today about the importance of women competing with men in the workplace and developing successful independent careers for themselves. My observation is that women who sacrifice their careers, at least in part, in the interest of their family, develop family identity, ties and unity, that will last long after they are called to their reward. If you still gather with your extended family around the holiday table and on special occasions; thank your mom.

The sense of sacrifice is there continuously, not just in the early formative years but for life. You could be the president of a large successful company, living in a mansion with servants, and your mother will still ask you if you are getting enough to eat, and if you're not over working yourself. That's how they are built; and for pity-sakes don't try to change that.

I would say mothers are the symbol of determination. When my eldest was born, I was at sea. My wife drove herself to the hospital when she went into labor. 127 miles of Alaskan wilderness from Seward Alaska to Elmendorf Airforce Base, in an old stick shift Bronco. She drove back with our daughter a few days after and had supper ready the day I pulled back into port. The amazing thing to me was; she made no big deal about it.

Oh yes, there will be the rebellious years of youth, when a child walks away and strikes out on their own. These are hard years for mom, but from my observation it is also hard on those who break away, and it may take years for the child to realize it. For the rebel, there is something missing. Something not quite so reassuring as when mom was around. There is nothing on earth quite like getting a smile from your mom, or hearing her voice. Still, when the tumult of life becomes too much and just too confusing, the young rebel turns back to the one reassuring person they know, mom. And Mom? Well, I have never seen a mom hesitate to embrace and take the child back in, no matter the age, no matter what has happened. When we talk about the prodigal son, and the father who rushed out to greet him upon his return, I like to think that back on the front porch there was a mother waiting patiently to do the same when father and son approached.

This then brings me back to the divine. Was it not a mother that had the courage to stand at the foot of her son's cross? From what I have observed, mothers who imitate and turn to the Blessed Virgin are in turn blest with the strength, fortitude and graces to weather any family storm.

A mother's heart is very special. One that is all tender and all loving, yet all so strong. Each of our mothers are blest with this type of heart, so honor them, and they will honor you with their love until the end of time.

# Nothing but a Number

Japanese mountain climber Yuichiro Miura reached the summit of Mount Everest at age 70. George Brunstad was also 70 when he swam the English Channel. Naval officer Grace Hopper became the first female rear admiral of the United States Navy when she was 79. Margaret Haggerty completed her quest to run a marathon on each of the seven continents when she was 84.

If stories like these teach us anything, it's that senior adults are capable of amazing things.

That was certainly true of Joshua. Even though he was probably nearing the century mark, God had a plan for him. Age didn't matter to God. Rather than telling Joshua to rest, retire or step aside for a younger replacement, God instructed him to get to work.

Perhaps we should take a cue from God in our attitude toward older adults. From an early age most of us were taught to respect our elders. However, too often we confuse politeness for respect. What's the difference? Politeness might include offering a hand to senior adults when they struggle with steps or making awkward small talk with aging relatives at family gatherings. Respect, however, would include realizing that with their years of challenges and experiences these adults are a rich, God-given resource.

In this age of politically correct labels, perhaps a better name for senior citizens is "ultra-experienced adults." God entrusted Joshua with an important duty a quarter century after Joshua reached retirement age because of his vast military experience and knowledge.

Think of the older adults you know. How does God want to use them in your life? What experiences of theirs might benefit you? What life lessons have they learned that might keep you from making a bad decision? And what might you be able to learn from hearing their stories and asking for their advice?
