To Be a Saint - Solitude Is Tricky Business

We often seek solitude; to be alone with our thoughts and our dreams, to enjoy a bit of personal relaxation, or just to clear our minds. Solitude is quite often a place we will find and establish a personal relationship with God. Indeed, it is where God speaks to us on a most intimate level.

We each develop our own methods of creating solitude for ourselves. We may find it in our daily tasks, or in taking a quiet walk in the country. It could be found in a daily commute to work, or in a comfortable spot where you feel at ease.

Do not confuse solitude with meditation. Meditation is more of a practice. There is a process to it, a developed skill that allows us to gain a deeper understanding of something within us, or life around us. Solitude is more of a state of being, where you purposely choose to be alone without the formality and processes required in meditation.

I would venture to say achieving solitude is more difficult for the young, since there is a whole world to be explored, relationships to be made, and experiences gained. As we age though, the fire dies down a bit, our curiosity becomes satisfied, and we are no longer on that rapid pace to experience. More often than not, we discover the enjoyment and benefits of solitude, and seek it out.

So, why is solitude tricky? What's not to like? I want to live my life in solitude.

"No man is an island", John Dunn, English poet and Anglican church cleric. This quote comes from one of Dunn's sermons and emphasizes that no one is truly self-sufficient. Mankind was created to be a social creature, and that prolonged solitude can lead to negative consequences.

The attractiveness of solitude is strong for some, but continual solitude which forsakes all human interaction, eventually becomes isolation, and as Dunn points out, it is not the natural state of man. We are not created for a self-imposed exile. Yes, there are the anchorites, Christian monks who spend their life in solitude, but they are far from being isolated, as they are supported by their communities, while they answer a special calling by God. Then there are loners and hermits of one sort or another. I have met several in my travels. These are ones that choose to disassociate themselves from society to varying degrees. I found that in each case there is a certain amount of worldly disillusionment, many are trying hard to escape from something, including reality. Depending on the degree of disassociation, there is a sense of bitterness about them. No, a self-imposed exile is futile.

Prolonged solitude becomes isolation, and the more we are isolated from society and mankind, the more we become socially, if not mentally deformed. There is a feeling of abandonment. It is analogous to spending time in prison, or creating a self-made tomb; a tomb which renders you dead to the world. God did not create us for this.

We are meant to live in this world and take an active part. We are meant to be Christlike. Indeed, if we are to receive our inheritance in the Kingdom of God we should consider the words from the gospel of Matthew. *"...for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me."* Then the righteous will answer him, *'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?'* And the king will answer them, *'Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me.'* Matt. 25:35-40. These words are those of Christian action, not of one who lives in self-imposed isolation.

Imitate Christ. Jesus often sought out solitude. He needed the time to refresh and to be alone with His Father, but remember each time Jesus sought solitude, He came back and continued His ministry. Jesus fulfilled God's plan. Can we do less.
