6 Ways to Guard Your Heart from Manipulative People

Not every person is safe. We must use wisdom when choosing and navigating the people in our lives. Unfortunately, it's not easy to find ways to be loving and maintain healthy boundaries when people we interact with and often love are manipulative.

Luke 6:31 says, "And as you wish that others would do to you, do so to them."

We must keep this in mind as we interact with others. We aren't to exact revenge, we are to let go of judgment and show others the kindness that we are looking for. Yet, healthy boundaries are a part of God's love.

Proverbs 4:23 says, "Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life." God wants us to guard our hearts so that they remain a source of his life for others. Thankfully, His Word guides us to keep our hearts safe when encountering unsafe people.

1. Be Wise with How and What We Share with Manipulative People

Proverbs 29:11 says, "A fool gives full vent to his spirit, but a wise man quietly holds it back." A fool shares everything and anything with others without consideration of whether the recipient is a safe place for this information. Wise people are discerning about how they share sensitive information. When interacting with a person you see has unhealthy tendencies, don't feel obligated to overshare with them.

I am a people pleaser, so this is hard for me! I want to reach out even when the other person has completely ghosted me. I'm often inclined to share our story freely because I desire connection. Including others is my superpower, but I've learned that being selective, thoughtful, and kind is a good way to guard your heart and calendar. I only have space for a limited number of safe, invested people. I have to prioritize them. People who don't know me well don't need to know everything about me or my family. If you are an extraverted empath, you will struggle with this, but the older I get, the more I see that my heart is precious and deserves to be cared for. Proverbs 18:7 warns, "A fool's mouth is his ruin, and his lips are a snare to his soul." Don't be a fool, control your mouth to remain safe in your relationships.

To Be a Saint - The Difficulty with Truth

Would you choose truth over lies and deception? How about truth over personal feelings; personal conviction? Which would you choose? Some will have a problem with the last question, but of course you choose truth. Consider though, on the whole, so would a satanist, so would a thief or a murderer. On a personal level, given a choice, we all seek the truth of things.

We seek to understand so that we can choose the right path, make the best decision, to gain enlightenment. All too often we seek like blind men, feeling, groping and grasping onto something that feels right, that aligns with what we think truth should be, or what is popular at the moment; and it is comfortable. And so, we grasp at it and call it truth. Eve sought this enlightenment, and in the process, grasped the one thing she and Adam was forbidden to have, which led to the downfall of mankind.

Truth often comes in a package that we do not understand or appreciate. The Sanhedrin could not accept Jesus Christ as the Messiah. Despite the many wonders and signs Jesus provided in the course of His ministry, it did not move them. Jesus simply was not what they were expecting; He was not what they wanted in a Messiah. In their blindness they crucified the one they had been waiting so long for.

Truth is not easy to come by, and we always are quick to look for the easy way to find it. We rely on others to show us the way. Scripture is perhaps the best example. After all it is God's word. But who has time to read and comprehend Scripture? We are looking for an easier way, so we seek truth from those who profess to have read and know Scripture. We then place complete trust in them without studying it for ourselves. In this way many are misled. Some others go in a different direction and place their trust in those who profess to know the stars and can read signs. They seek truth through spells, witchcraft, magic charms and incantations.

Today is arguably worse than any time in history. We have so many diversions and distractions from reality, each peddling their brand of truth. Some people spend their life consumed in games of make believe. Then there are those who follow celebrities and seek to mimic everything they do. Then there are the false political philosophies. How many countless souls have followed the siren's cry of socialism only to find ruin and destruction.

Truth never changes, but our understanding of truth does. When we were young, we believed in Santa Claus and the tooth fairy. For that time in our life that was true to us. As we grew older, we came to realize the truth of it, and learned to separate truth from legend and lore. This time is a great awakening for us, we learn to question what we think is true. A beautiful time of forming moral values and truth finding; it is also a vulnerable time. Without the daily guidance of loving parents, family structure, and traditional institutions like the church, the young will naturally develop their truth and moral compass from other sources, and along the lines of what is popular in our society. For despite the natural rebellion of youth, they are after all looking for acceptance, and will find their truth in that which seems attractive, easiest, and popular.

There is an interplay between truth and love. The concept is a foundational principle in Christian theology, emphasizing the harmonious relationship between truth and love in the life of a believer. This principle is rooted in the teachings of Jesus Christ. Truth without love can become legalistic and harsh, while love without truth can lead to compromise, relativism and social breakdown.

Let's sum it up. Those who seek truth, and live by truth, are often misunderstood, and feel out of place in a world where truth holds little value. To follow truth sometimes is to go against our very nature. We need to practice our truth to be sure of it; for the weak minded, truth can be fragile and easily manipulated. To speak the truth can be life threatening. That is why whenever you find truth, you find uncommon courage, uncommon love. Consider these last few lines. Do they not define what it means to be Christian? Substitute the word faith for truth to see what I mean. Are we not called to be truth seekers? We find our truth in Jesus Christ; Who is the way, the truth and the life.
