7 Spiritual Disciplines That Boost Your Mental Health

Your spiritual and mental health are connected. Practicing spiritual disciplines can deepen your faith and strengthen your mind.

SLIDE 6 OF 7

6. Resting in God's Presence - Embracing Stillness

In today's rushed and stressful world, taking time to <u>notice and rest in God's presence</u> is vital for mental and emotional well-being. <u>Jesus</u> prioritized rest during his earthly life, and he says in <u>Matthew 11:28</u>: "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." Many people feel pressured to stay constantly busy, believing productivity defines their worth. However, God calls you to slow down and rest by trusting that he is in control. Resting in God's presence also involves solitude and silence. In a world filled with noise – from social media, news, work responsibilities, and more – it's easy to lose touch with God's still, small voice. <u>Jesus</u> often withdrew to quiet places to pray (<u>Luke 5:16</u>). Taking even a few minutes each day to sit in silence before God, breathing deeply and focusing on God's presence, can help you experience

God's peace.

Another way to rest in God's presence is through reflection and surrender. Sometimes, carrying burdens never meant to be yours can exhaust you mentally.

Psalm 46:10 reminds you: "Be still, and know that I am God."

When you truly rest in God's presence, you let go of the need to control everything and trust that God is in control and will work everything out for the best. This surrender can relieve you of the heavy burdens of stress and <u>anxiety</u>. Resting in God isn't passive; it's active. When you rest in God, you cooperate with him to bring renewal and revival to your life. Rest helps you create space for God's healing presence to restore you from the inside out.

To Be a Saint – Through the Eyes of the Virgin Mary

When this letter is published, we should have just commemorated two great feast days, the Ascension of Our Lord on 29 May, and the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Elizabeth, 31 May. Let's consider the connections between the two great feast days and the indispensable role of Mary. But first some grounding.

In his gospel, Luke recounts how he spoke with, "...eye witnesses and ministers of the word". Lk 1:2. He then spends the first two chapters of his gospel covering the most intimate of details concerning the pronouncement of the Archangel Gabriel to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Luke gives us a precise recounting of the birth of Jesus, including the Roman census, the journey to Bethlehem, the visit of the shepherds; even the intimate moment of the child being wrapped in swaddling clothes and laid in a manger. Details that only a mother could provide. No doubt Luke had lengthy discussions with Mary; the eye witness closest to Jesus.

The Visitation - "At that time Mary got ready and hurried to a town in the hill country of Judea, where she entered Zechariah's home and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. In a loud voice she exclaimed: 'Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the child you will bear! But why am I so favored, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? As soon as the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for joy. Blessed is she who has believed that the Lord would fulfill his promises to her!" (Luke 1:39-45)

Luke describes Mary as "Hurrying". Why the hurry? Perhaps the Catechism of the Church can shed light. "The Virgin Mary is the supreme model of this collaboration of the will of God, with a full and active acceptance of the divine will and an unwavering faith in its fulfillment" (CCC 148). In doing God's will, no creature ever surpassed the Blessed Virgin Mary. We should imitate that and not delay in the service of the Lord.

The encounter between Mary and Elizabeth is a moment of joy and divine recognition. Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, acknowledges the presence of the Lord within Mary, she said the baby in my womb leaped for joy. The word "leaped" appears also in scripture when King David "leaped" and danced before the Ark of the Covenant. Now, John the Baptist leaps before the new Ark of the Covenant.

This Visitation was important to God's design. We are told Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. As mother and child are so wonderfully connected during pregnancy, so too the infant she carried, John, was filled with the Holy Spirit upon this meeting. It might be said that at this moment John was sanctified and commissioned for his great work. Ordained in Heaven, this meeting, after Mary's acceptance at the Annunciation, was the second great work of God's plan of salvation.

The Ascension - Scripture tells us that the Apostles were with Jesus on Mount Olivet when He was taken up into heaven before their eyes. Was not the safeguarding of the Blessed Virgin

given to the Apostle John? Mary was present in Jerusalem, a place that was still dangerous to the disciples and the family of Jesus, so why would John leave Mary behind? Indeed, did John really have a say in the matter? Why would Jesus want to depart from His mother without a chance for her to say one last goodbye, and watch her Son ascend in glory? She had earned that at least. Of note, tradition dating back to Apostolic times also has the Blessed Virgin being at the Ascension.

What conversation might they have had at this parting. For her part, I have no doubt that the moment would have been filled with tenderness combined with trust, and a continuing desire to see God's will completed. I would like to think the final gaze of our Lord was upon His mother; indeed, His first disciple.

Consider that the Holy Spirit was a promise to the others, but for Mary, the Holy Spirit had already filled her and remained part of her; the same Spirit which filled Elizabeth and the Forerunner John. Mary had no need to wait in Jerusalem for Pentecost, but did so to steady the others until the Holy Spirit filled them also. Luke says in Chapter 1 of Acts, that while they waited in Jerusalem for the Holy Spirit, "they were of one accord". I sense once more the gentle touch of the Blessed Virgin, accomplishing the will of God.

The Blessed Virgin Mary never counted the personal cost in any sacrifice that she made. She was consumed with the love of our Lord and desire to do His will. How ready are we to do the same?
