**Parking Lot Replacement Fundraiser** - Our parking lot is in a terrible state. There is one section in front of the church hall that is actually leeching dirt from the subsurface during heavy rains. At best that area is a tripping hazard; at worst, continued erosion will one day create a terrible sinkhole. Other sections of the parking lot are so weak that leaf blowers will actually blow away rotten asphalt. We've done sealing repairs twice over the last few years, but that no longer remains a viable option. We need a new parking lot.

The Plan..... Estimates are being gathered, but the simple fact is we do not have the amount of money required to contract the job out. As those numbers come together, we will make it known, but the cost could be in excess of \$75K-\$100K. In the interim, the parish plans to install a professional asphalt repair in the area in front of the hall, where the subsoil is is leeching through. The cost of the repair is something the parish can afford now, while buying us needed time..... In that time Ascension will be conducting a fund raiser to install the new parking lot. Details will be announced soon. Father Alex.

## Our Daily Bread – The Two Trees

The Colorado Springs shooter identified as non-binary.

The Denver shooter identified as trans.

The Aberdeen shooter identified as trans.

The Nashville shooter identified as trans.

The Minneapolis shooter is identified as trans.

OK, it would seem if we just got rid of the “trans and non-binary”, problem solved, right? I could make a similar list of other shootings, bombings and terrorist events just as bad. Events perpetrated by people who are not trans or non-binary. Would it make a difference if we got rid of them also? There would be others to take their place.

All sin comes from rebellion against God. Transitioning from what God made you into something else is a rebellion against the Creator, but so to all hatred, vengeance, pride and so on.

Many will cry that it's the gun's fault. Others will say its government's fault, or its society's fault, or it's Trumps fault, they all miss the mark. The shooter of course carries the burden of having committed the crime, but make no mistake, there are many accomplices, and in order to begin to correct this we have to find the root cause.

Root causes? Accomplices? To see the problem clearly, let passions subside and reason guide. For years many have been alarmed at the skyrocketing number of children who are being “transitioned,” and prescribed powerful drugs including estrogen and testosterone, and pushed on a pathway towards body-mutilating surgery. Transgender activists pretend that puberty blockers and hormones are “harmless” and proven “treatments” for gender dysphoria. In reality, these “treatments” involve powerful drugs that can have life-long, irreversible effects, including mood changes, anxiety, depression, life-long sterility, osteoporosis, and various cognitive disorders. If you look at each of the cases I mentioned in the beginning, you will find evidence of this. The shooters have been conditioned for this, a concept I have tried to develop over a couple of letters.

So, it's the doctors and trans community that is at fault. Accomplices yes, but the root cause lies elsewhere. Then it's the parent's fault, its liberal education's fault, it's the fault of a CIA mind control program. Once again, we are grasping at the physical. There may be culpability there to a degree, but it is still not the root cause.

Ultimate responsibility lies not in the temporal realm, the realm we can see. It lies in the spiritual realm, the invisible realm which many deny, yet the results are there for all to see. I'll use an analogy of the tree of life and the tree of death. We are all familiar with the tree of life. It was present in Genesis, in the Garden of Eden, and is also described in Revelation. It is often associated with Jesus Christ. Indeed, Jesus is described as the true vine in the Gospels of Matthew and John.

Let's move on to the Tree of Death. Saint Augustine was the first to observe that Satan is the “Ape of God”. Satan seeks to imitate God, but in a clumsy ape like fashion. A cheap imitation with the express purpose of countering God. As Christ is described as the tree of life, so Satan has set himself up as an imitation, but in his case the tree of death, for by his very nature Satan's action will invariably lead to corruption, sin and death. As with the tree of life, the tree of death has many branches to support its activities. It is upon these branches that Satan's tree of death sets its fruit. In the case of the Minneapolis

shooter, Robin Westman is the fruit. It was the branches, the parents and other accomplices mentioned above, that nourished him and led him along.

I read a note the shooter left for his family. He said it pains him to bring this storm into their lives. He said he was tired of being trans and that he was corrupted by this world, and has learned to hate what life is. He said to hold onto what you are, not to what “I am”. To me, this is a final cry of desperation, the end of a losing fight against a demon who has taken control of him. Now, balance this with words from his manifesto concerning fantasies about killing innocent children; and wanting to be a “scary horrible monster standing over those powerless kids”. Hear in this the hiss of the demonic speaking? Hear Satan's whisper; this soul is mine!! The fruit of the tree of death, tended so well, had ripened and fell. All who had a hand in this boy's fall holds some responsibility in his rebellion, but the root cause came from the tree of death.

I spoke to you before about grounding values. That is what is missing here. Primarily the value of respect. Respect for yourself in the way you were created. Respect of others as precious creations of God. Respect leads to appreciation, which leads to love and self-fulfillment. These are things of the tree of life, whose branches (counterparts to the tree of death) sustain, guide and instill all such values. Guided by such as these, that boy would not have taken the course he did. The tree of death would have had no hold on him.
